

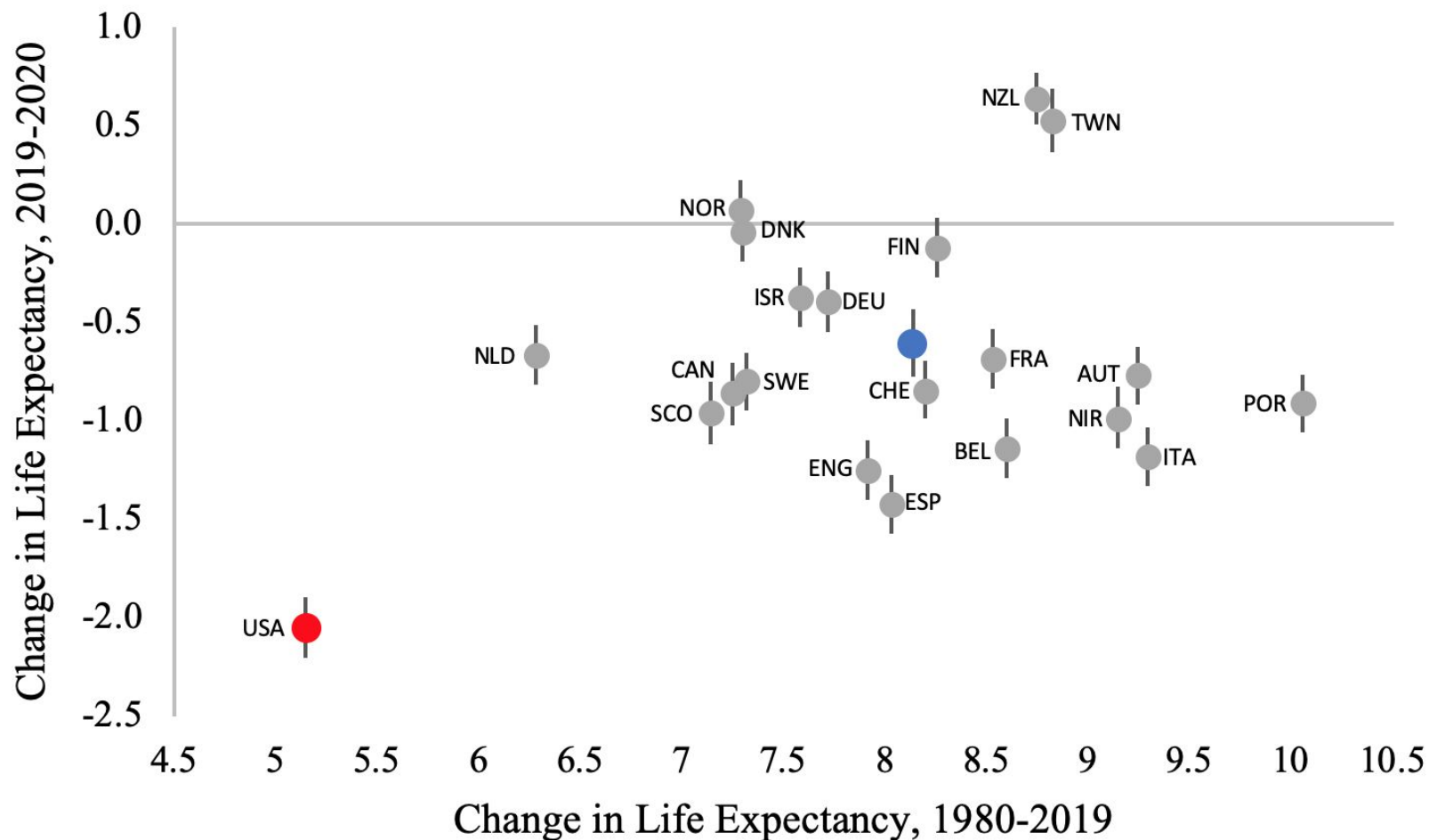

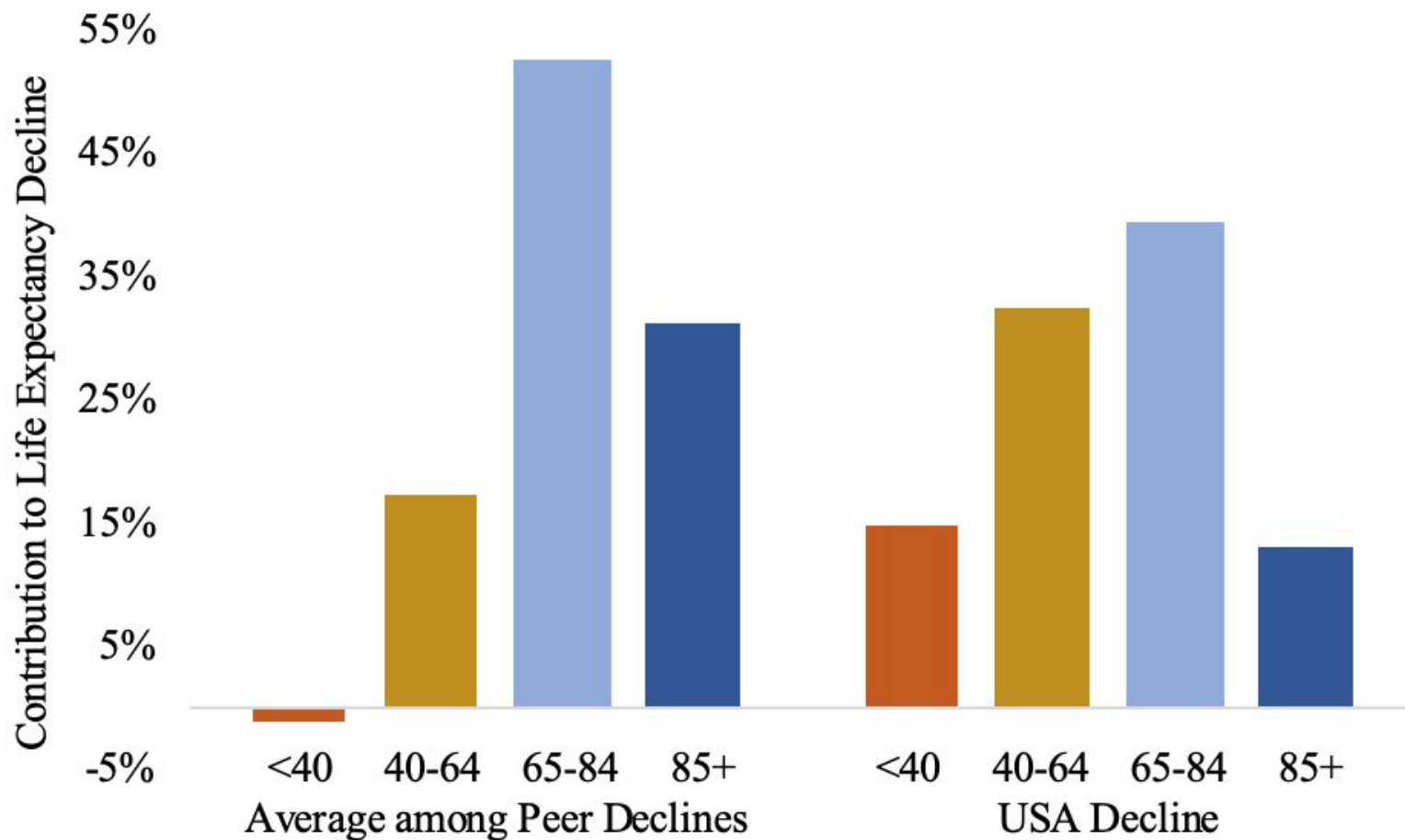

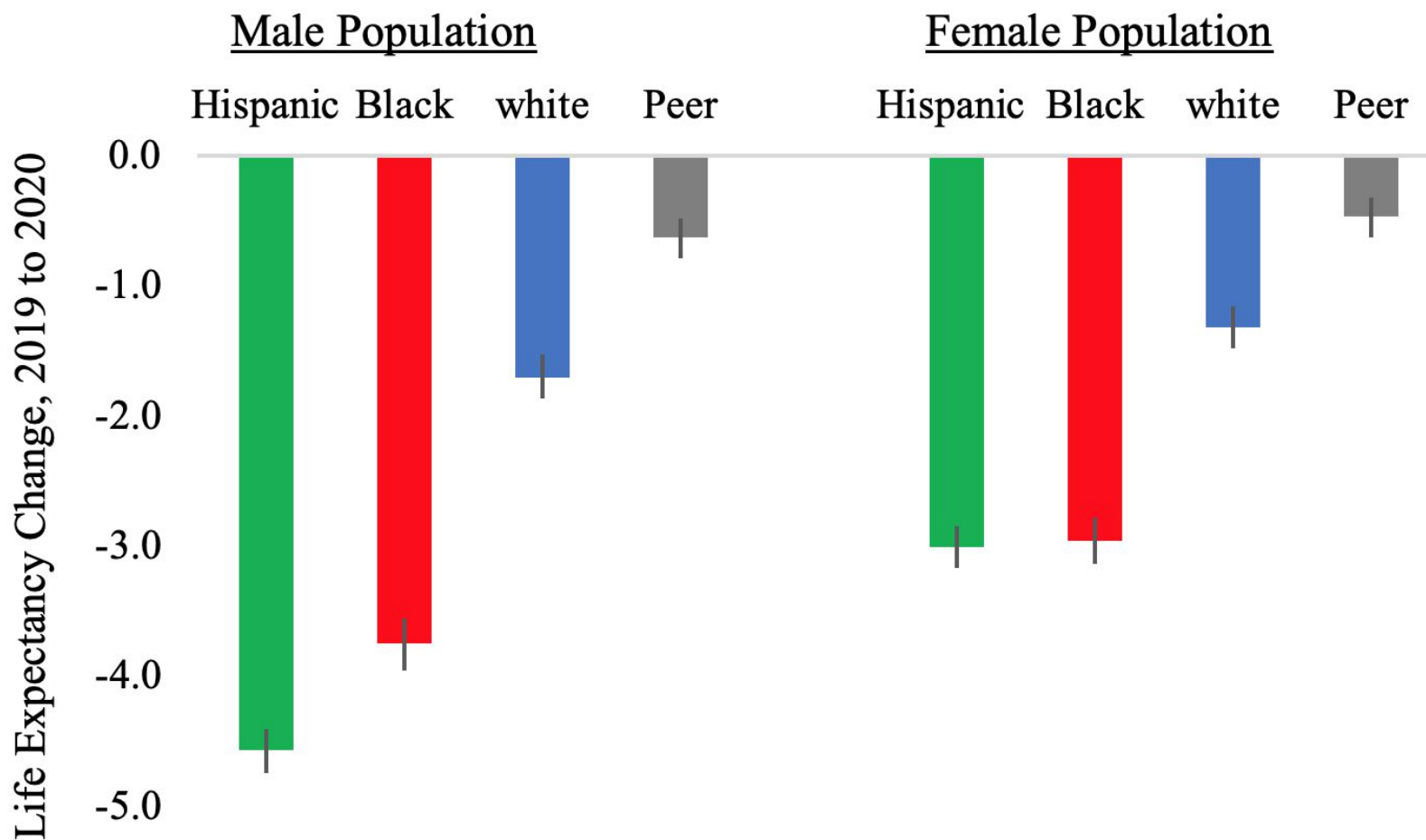
United States as a Conspicuous Outlier



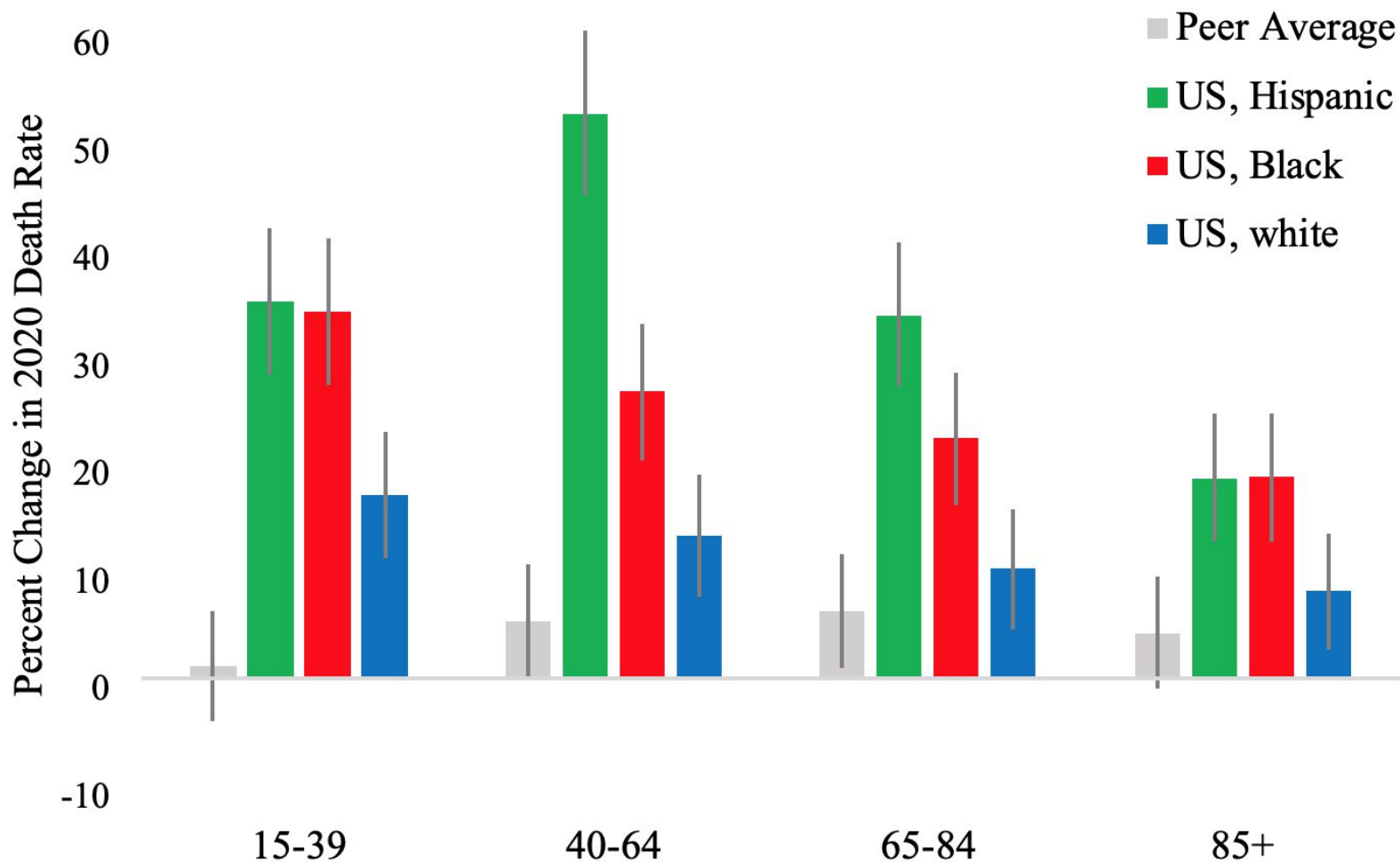
Loss of U.S. Life = Deaths at Younger Ages

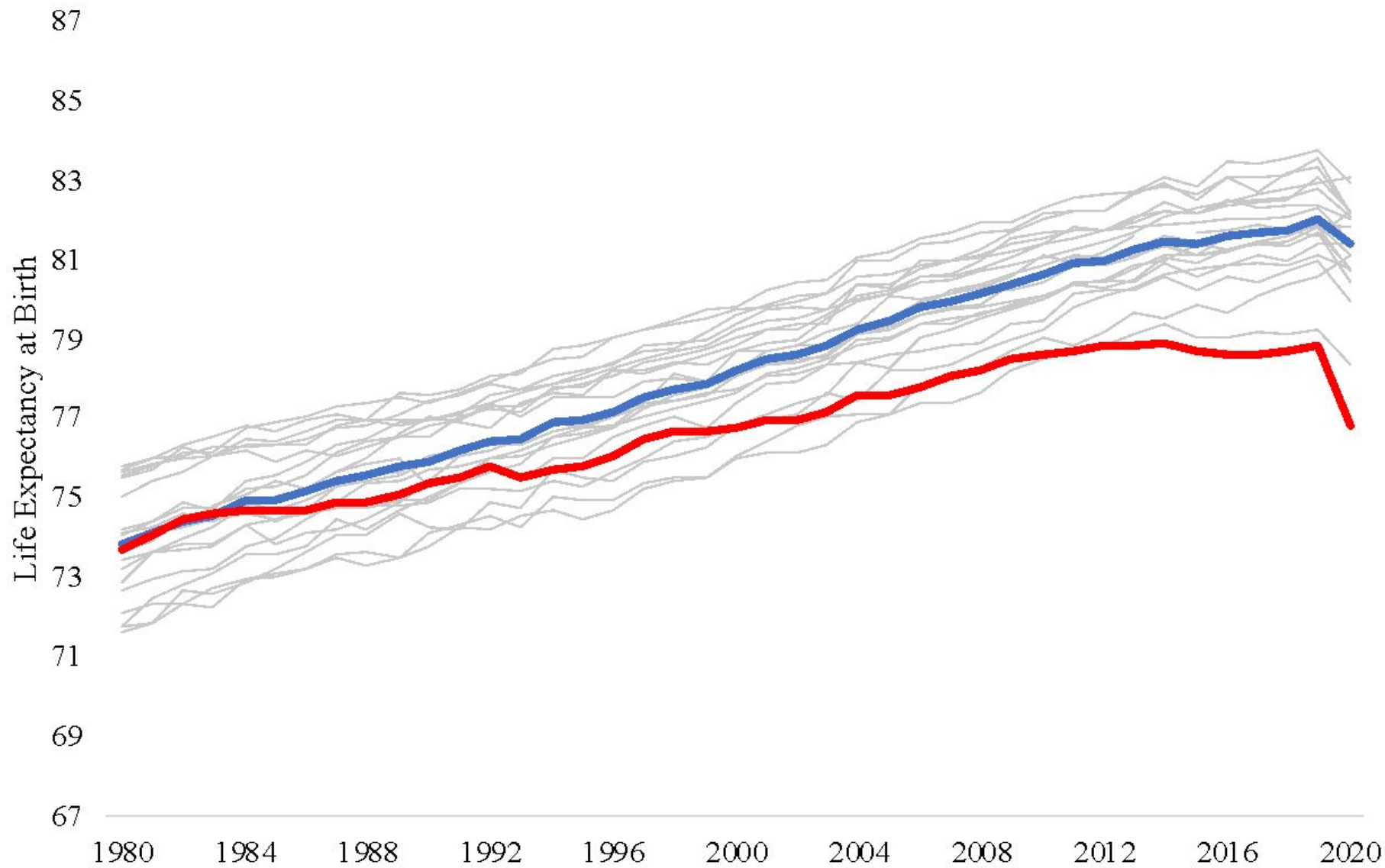


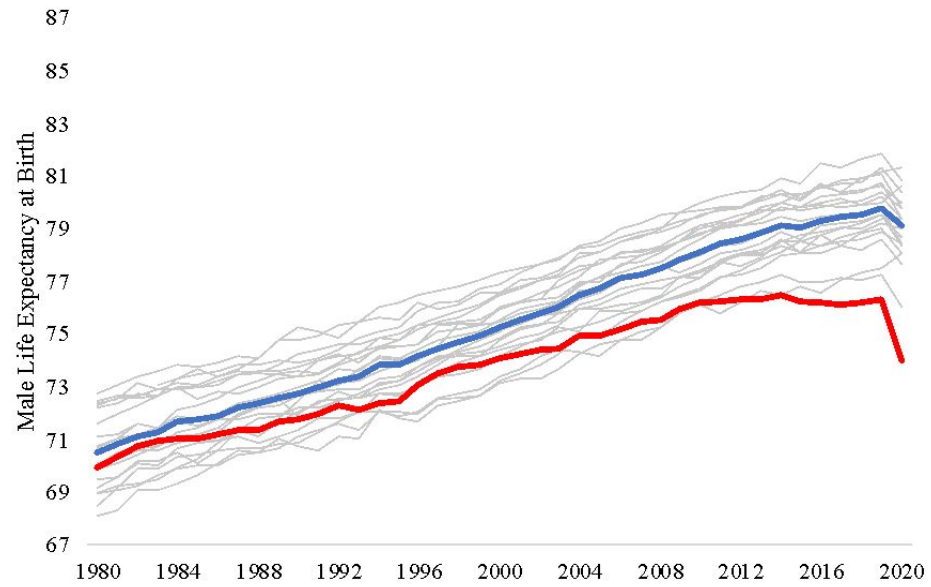
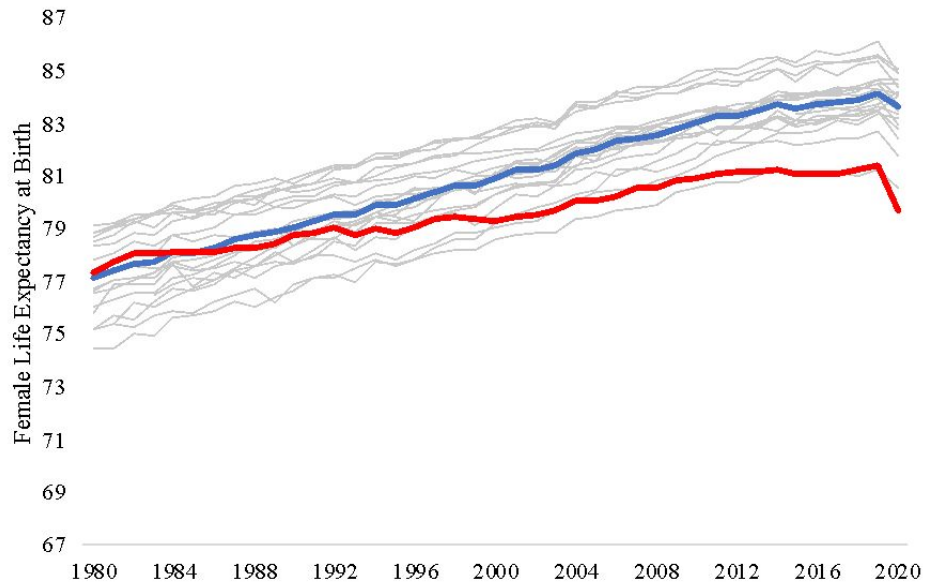
Loss of Life Expectancy by U.S. Race/Ethnicity



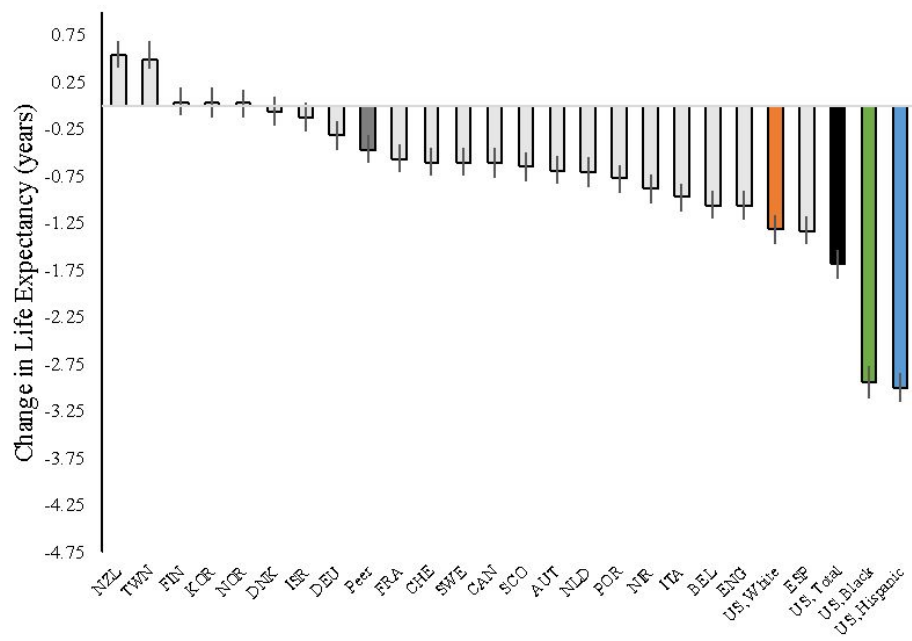
Increase in Men's Death Rates by Age
